

These Regulations concern the establishment of rules for the granting of press accreditations, entitling to participate in the scope and under the rules set out below in the CSIO International CSIO Competition, which will take place from June 13 to June 16, 2019.

Submitting an application for accreditation is tantamount to acceptance of the rules.

1. There are three types of journalistic accreditation: MEDIA, FOTO and TV crew
2. Journalistic accreditations at CSIO Sopot 2019 are provided free of charge to professionally active representatives of international, national and local media (press, television, radio, Internet) delegated to media service CSIO Sopot 2019. In other cases, it is possible to purchase accreditation at a gross price of 300 PLN.
3. The final decision on granting accreditation (unpaid and paid) is made by the Organizer.

1. GENERAL RULES

1. Journalists who have been granted accreditation receive a wristband entitling them to enter strictly defined zones.
2. The map with specified in point 1 zones will be sent by e-mail, no later than the day preceding the competition.
3. Accredited persons are obliged to place the accreditation in a place visible to the security services.
4. Entrance to the parcours for competition takes place only with the consent of the main judge of the competition under the supervision of the coordinator. The basis for entering the parcours during the competition (designated zones) and prize giving ceremony (designated zone) is the possession of a special pass, which can be obtained directly from the Press Officer. The number of passes is limited.
5. Accredited persons are asked due to the rank of the event and television broadcast for the appropriate dress - long pants / skirt, shirt, jacket. The organizer reserves the right to refuse access for a prize giving ceremony for people who do not comply with the specified "dress code".
6. Persons who have been granted accreditation agree to put their e-mail addresses in the Organizer's database, process personal data for accreditation and agree to receive newsletters (not often than 2 per week in the weeks preceding the competition, and one per day during week of competition)) from the address media@csio.sopot.pl regarding CSIO Sopot 2019.

7. Prepared by accredited journalists materials from CSIO Sopot 2019 can be used only to the extent that it does not violate the rights of other people, including the right to the image, personal rights, trademark rights.
8. Accredited journalists can not interfere with the course of the event, and make it difficult for the audience to receive the event. There is a total ban on shooting with a flash and blocking communication routes, passages, escape routes, entries and exits from the competition area.
9. The accreditation does not entitle its holders to enter the VIP tent. You can buy an entry ticket to enter the VIP tent. If you are interested, please contact media@csio.sopot.pl.
10. Interviews with competitors, guests and representatives of the Organizing Committee are arranged by the Press Officer by address: media@csio.sopot.pl. For this purpose, before the start of the International CSIO Competition Sopot 2019, an accredited person will provide an email to the above address with a list of people with whom the accredited person would like to conduct an interview. The organizer reserves the right to refuse to arrange a meeting if the competitor does not agree.
11. The organizer is entitled to remove the accredited from the event and to withdraw the accreditation in the following cases:
 - a) the accredited does not comply with any of the rules set out in these regulations or violates the provisions of generally applicable law.
 - b) accredited by his behavior creates a danger for other participants or makes it difficult to conduct.
 - c) The accredited provided the accreditation document to a third party to enable it to enter the event or otherwise violate the rules of using the accreditation.
 - d) Accredited does not apply to the Organizer's instructions or persons authorized by the Organizer.

2. RULES OF AWARING ACCREDITATION

1. The condition for granting the accreditation is to complete the application for journalistic accreditation and send it to the email address media@csio.sopot.pl by 12/06/2019. The application for accreditation is available at www.csio.sopot.pl in the MEDIA / ACREDITATIONS tab. It can also be sent by e-mail at the request of a journalist.
2. Accreditations are issued on the basis of the presentation of a press ID or after presenting current publications, f.ex.: social media channels, blogs, websites related to the subject of the event (sporting events, equestrian events).

3. For authors who do not have a press card, minimum limits have been adopted, f.ex.
 - Instagram: 4,000 followers
 - Facebook: 4,000 likes
 - YouTube: 4,000 subscribers
 4. For creators who do not meet the requirements of point 3, a paid accreditation has been prepared for PLN 300 gross. In order to purchase the accreditation, you should report by e-mail to the following address: media@csio.sopot.pl
 5. In the case of paid accreditation, the amount of PLN 300 will be paid by the person who has been accredited by transfer to the Organizer's bank account, given in an e-mail or in cash at the moment of receipt of the accreditation
 6. The decision on granting the accreditation will be sent electronically to the address indicated in the application for accreditation immediately, but no later than June 12, 2019
 7. Accreditations can be collected in person at the accreditation point from ul. Polna until June 16, 2019.
 8. The CSIO Sopot 2019 organizer reserves the right to refuse to grant accreditation without giving a reason. The decision in this matter is final.

1. People who have been accepted for press accreditation are asked to:
 - After accepting the application, we ask for publishing information about the CSIO Sopot 2019 competition on the website / channel / blog / magazine on the basis of materials available at www.csio.sopot.pl.
 - Sending to the media@csio.sopot.pl a link to the page with the place of publication.
 2. Accredited journalists when collecting materials and their use are required to comply with the generally applicable laws and third party rights, and in particular must not violate the right to the image of third parties, other personal rights, including copyright.
